

Adult Oral Health Survey 2023 Call for Dental Examiners

About the study

The 2023 Adult Oral Health Survey for England is being undertaken by a consortium comprising The National Centre for Social Research (NatCen) and the universities of London (Kings & UCL), Birmingham and Newcastle. We are seeking **dentists and dental therapists** to accompany a NatCen interviewer to people's homes and undertake dental examinations.

These examinations are designed to collect information for assessing population health and so are not the same as normal clinical dental examinations but require similar skills.

What we offer

All training and materials will be provided. If you are not taking part as part of your usual employment or training, you will be employed as a casual worker on a rate equivalent to £32.88 per hour including holiday pay. You will need to commit to information security / data protection practices.

Previous experience of undertaking this work is helpful but not essential. All examiners must be fit to undertake exposure-prone procedures and not be subject to any restrictions by the GDC or NHS.

Travel expenses will be paid during fieldwork.

CPD hours will be awarded for training. Accommodation will be arranged where needed and travel expenses paid for attending training. Only examiners who successfully complete the training and calibration exercise will be allowed to undertake fieldwork; the training and calibration events are not designed as 'standalone' CPD training courses. Please consider your availability carefully and undertake any checks with your line manager (if applicable) before expressing your interest.

Key requirements:

- You must attend the two-day training and calibration session on: 16th & 17th January 2024 (Resource for London, 365 Holloway Road, London N7 6PA. *Time* TBC);
- You <u>MUST</u> be able to commit fully to the 3 months of fieldwork in your preferred area between January and the end of March 2024;
- You must be flexible in the time and availability you give to work on the study.

Your role

Fieldwork (visits to homes) will take place at various times of the day e.g. during and after normal office working hours with some commitment required at weekends.

A typical examiner workload will involve visiting **35** homes during the fieldwork period and carrying out **50** examinations across **2** fieldwork areas. The exact number will depend on local factors such as success in recruiting households to the survey.

We are seeking to recruit examiners to provide coverage across several fieldwork areas set out in the appendix to this advert. Ideally examiners will work in at least 2 of these areas. When responding, please indicate which fieldwork areas you are be able to work in (you can select more than 2 even if you only wish to work in 2).

Those being released from their usual employment to participate will normally be expected to be reimbursed and indemnified under those arrangements.

For those being employed specifically for the survey, we will require face to face right to work checks and DBS checks prior to the training period.
