Fathers' involvement with children

A father's presence has a huge impact on the development and wellbeing of their child. This paper includes a range of tables using data from the UK-wide survey Understanding Society (2009-11¹) which profile the things which parents do with children and the interactions between parents and children.

Table conventions

- All data has been weighted using survey weights, however weighted bases are not shown
- All percentages have been rounded to the nearest whole per cent
- Where the unweighted base is less than 50 cases the per cent is shown in square brackets and caution should be placed on this finding due to the small base size []
- Where the per cent is less than 0.5 but greater than 0 a '+' symbol is shown
- Where there are no cases in the category a '0' is shown
