Middle Britons (26%)



Left-Behind Patriots (15%)



Well-off Traditionalists (12%)



Soft-Left Liberals (14%)




Apolitical Centrists (17%)



Urban Progressives (16%)




Economic policy: Does big business benefits owners at the expense of workers?





Economic policy: Should the Government redistribute income from the better-off to those who are less well off?





Law and order: Should people who break the law be given stiffer sentences?






And how much do you trust politicians of any party in Britain to tell the truth when they are in a tight corner?


Generally speaking, do you think of yourself as a supporter of any one political party?




If there were a referendum today to decide whether Britain does or does not become a member of the European Union, would you vote in favour or would you vote against?


What are the voter types' political preferences?
